Attendees will learn practical strategies for structuring clear, visually effective lessons that support diverse learning styles and improve comprehension. Through educator-focused examples and a live demonstration, participants will gain confidence in creating professional presentations that elevate the learning experience while reducing preparation time.

Course Objectives:

1. Identify key features of Gamma that support effective lesson presentation design.
2. Organize lesson content into clear, structured, and visually engaging presentations.
3. Apply basic instructional design principles to enhance student engagement and retention.
4. Demonstrate how Gamma can be used to efficiently create professional-quality lesson materials.
5. Integrate Gamma into dental assisting education to support confidence and consistency in teaching.
